THE REHABILITATION CENTER was

established in Wenatchee in 1998 and the unit is licensed for 9 beds. In 2002, the Rehab Center was accredited by the Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities (CARF) and has been recertified every 3 years thereafter. In 2014 the Rehabilitation Center became Stroke certified and is also a Trauma Level II Rehabilitation facility.

Other services of Confluence Health support the Rehabilitation Center. These services include the Walk-In Clinic, Medical/Surgical Unit, Surgery Center, X-ray, Laboratory, and Physician Specialty Clinic. Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy and Speech Pathology all provide outpatient services in addition to inpatient services.
